Resolution to Approve the Durling Annexation, 0.106 Acre, South Side of Valley Drive, West of Dexter Road (CPC Recommendation: Approval - 9 Yeas and 0 Nays)

Approval of this resolution will allow annexation of this property from Scio Township into the City. The property is within the City's water and sewer service area, and the current use is consistent with the adjacent zoning, land uses and master plan. Council action on the proposed R1C (Single Family District) zoning will be scheduled after the annexation process is complete.

The City Planning Commission, at its meeting of January 15, 2019, recommended approval of the request.
