Resolution to Approve Ongoing Subscription with Zoom Video Communications, Inc for Meeting and Webinar Services (\$50,000.00) (8 Votes Required)

The attached resolution seeks approval of City Council in the amount of \$50,000.00 on behalf of the Information Technology Services Unit. These funds are needed to maintain Zoom licensing on a monthly basis to support meetings and webinars to conduct City business during social distancing due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Zoom is the communication platform for City Council meetings, Boards and Commissions, and a variety of other community outreach services.

Budget/Fiscal Impact: This purchase was unexpected and is not budgeted in the FY21 Information Technology budget. It is requested that \$50,000 be appropriated from the FY21 Information Technology Fund fund balance to cover the cost of this purchase.
